Harvest Bowl: A Rural Solution for a Rural Problem

Buy Local, Buy Fresh and Mennonite Community Services are partnering with local farmers, and community organizations to provide a gleaning service and further processing of produce to create packages of dry soup mix for distribution county wide for the needs of our less fortunate. Their intent this year is to glean and dehydrate during the harvest glut. Dehydrated product will be saved in plastic bags in large bins. Once there is enough ingredients they will divide the product into small bags of dry soup mix. A dietician will create the soup mix recipes. This year will be a pilot project which will be evaluated to see how to move forward to enrich the lives of our community. They are looking for volunteer help next week Tuesday or Wednesday (not sure which day or time yet) at South Dorchester Community Hall in Lyons to help prepare sweet potatoes for dehydrating.
